To Create a Just Society
through Involvement in Socio, Civic & Political Affairs

The Aims & Objects of the Sabha are :

1. To promote the social, economic, political, cultural, educational and general welfare of Catholics in particular and Christians in general.
2. To promote fraternal solidarity among Catholics in the Archdiocese of Bombay; to establish units in all the Parishes and to co-ordinate their activities.
3. To foster in particular civic, social, political and national consciousness among Catholics; to help them to play a useful and effective role in public life and to contribute to national integration and welfare.
4. To be exponents of Catholic opinion and to spread the influence of Christian ideals, values and principles in public life.
5. To safeguard the legitimate rights, liberties and interest of the Christian community and to make representation to public and private authorities and bodies in a matters affecting Christians.
6. To undertake humanitarian work, projects or schemes for the needy, irrespective of race, caste, creed or community and to do charitable work in general.
7. To affiliate to the All India Catholic Union and other regional, national, or international Catholic organisations and to co-operate with Christian and other bodies having aims and objectives similar to those of the Sabha.
8. To promote renewal within the Church and to foster good relationships through dialogue, collaboration and services between the Church and Society, in keeping with the policy and programmes of the Catholic Church.
9. To raise, borrow and to spend funds, to receive or use any gift, donation or foundation in cash or kind, to own and dispose of movable or immovable properties and to own and manage institutions for the fulfillment of the objectives of the Sabha.
10. To take all measures necessary for or incidental and conducive to the attainment or advancement of the aims and the objectives of the Sabha.
